I-66 Multimodal Project, I-395 Express Lanes, Regional Bus & Transit Ridership among Items of Interest

•*Transform 66 Inside the Beltway Multimodal Project*

Commissioners will be asked to approve the steps necessary to implement the program.

•*I-395 Express Lanes Northern Extension Project*

Commissioners will discuss VDOT's plan to extend the I-395 express lanes and include guaranteed funding for transit, carpooling and transportation demand management.

•*Regional Bus*

NVTC will release maps depicting opportunities for bus rapid transit (BRT) and express bus services. The maps highlight current and proposed BRT networks in Northern Virginia and identify current and proposed managed (HOT) lanes where there are opportunities for expanded commuter and express bus services.

•*Quarterly Ridership Report*

NVTC will report on transit ridership in Northern Virginia for the second quarter of FY 2016.
