•*Transform 66: Inside the Beltway Multimodal Program Memorandum of Agreement*
Commissioners will vote on authorizing NVTC's executive director to execute the Transform 66: Inside the Beltway Multimodal Program Memorandum of Agreement.

•*WMATA Regional Forums*

NVTC's executive director will update Commissioners on forums that will allow the public to share concerns about WMATA and identify solutions to get Metro back on track. The Dec. 16 and 17 forums will include a presentation and roundtables where participants will prioritize issues and pinpoint solutions aimed at helping WMATA improve the safety and reliability of the transit system.

•*Virginia Railway Express Station Opening and Service Expansion*

VRE's CEO will update Commissioners on the opening of the Spotsylvania Station and the expansion of service along the Fredericksburg Line. More than 500 passengers boarded trains in Spotsylvania County on Nov. 16, opening day. Spotsylvania becomes the southern terminus for VRE train service on the line and represents the first extension of VRE service since it began operations in 1992. On Nov. 30, VRE added an additional train to the Fredericksburg Line, bringing the number of daily roundtrip trains to eight.
