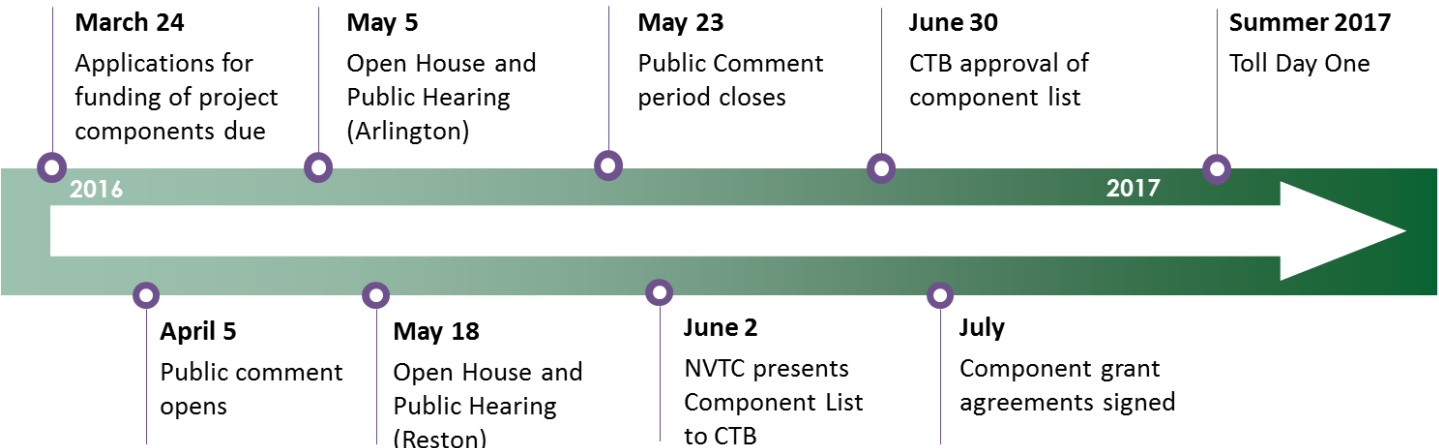
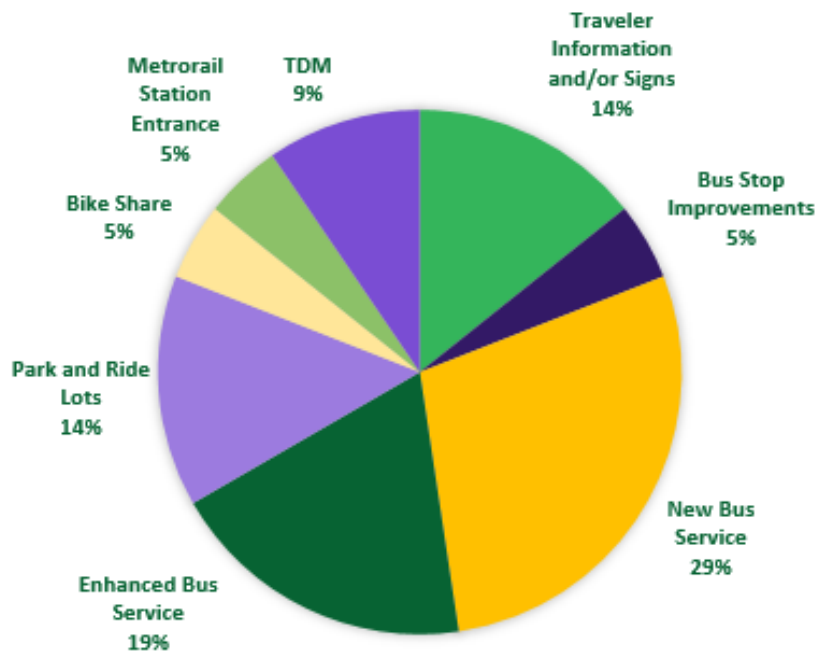
Transportation Improvements Eligible for Funding

NVTC is leading the Transform 66 Multimodal Project. In order to move more people through the I-66 corridor as quickly and efficiently as possible, the Commission will identify and fund transit and road improvements that benefit toll payers. NVTC has received 19 applications from six jurisdictions and transit providers in District 8 for component funding.

The public may comment on the submitted components at public hearings on May 5 and 18 and may submit comments through the close of business on May 23. A list of applications is available on the web at www.NoVaTransit.org/i66multimodal.

NVTC has scored the applications based on criteria that the Commission approved at its March meeting. The scores and criteria are available online. In June, the Commission will prioritize and approve a list of components for Initial funding and forward it to the Commonwealth Transportation Board. Grant agreements will be executed in July so that the initial components are in place by summer 2017.
